**THE CALL OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD**

The Twenty-third Psalm, today's responsorial psalm, is arguably the best known of all the psalms. The line that reads "Even though I walk in the dark valley / I fear no evil; for you are at my side / with your rod and your staff / that give me courage" (Psalm 23:4) connects this week's scriptures to the wonderful story of the road to Emmaus, which we heard last week. The Lord Jesus, our Good Shepherd, is constantly at our side. He calls us each by name, beckoning us into a deeper relationship with him. That call, issued to each of us at the moment of our baptism, carries with it the promise of the Good Shepherd: "I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly" (John 10:10).

# Faith Formation Corner

## The Voice of the Good Shepherd in the Internet?

“The sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice” (Jn 10:4). How do we recognize Christ’s voice today? In today’s Gospel, Christ describes how we will recognize his voice through the image of the shepherd and the flock. Christ applies to himself not only the title of Good Shepherd but also the door into the sheepfold.

“The Church is a sheepfold whose one and indispensable door is Christ. It is a flock of which God Himself foretold He would be the shepherd, and whose sheep, although ruled by human shepherds; are nevertheless continuously led and nourished by Christ Himself, the Good Shepherd and the Prince of the shepherds, who gave His life for the sheep” (Lumen Gentium, 6).

Faced with strange voices in the world today, we, the flock, are confused. As we open the Internet, we are bombarded with so much data. We get confused because many sites provide us with different, opposing and even false news. The Church has already noted, “The spread of the Internet also raises a number of other ethical questions about matters like privacy, the security and confidentiality of data, copyright and intellectual property law, pornography, hate sites, the dissemination of rumor and character assassination under the guise of news, and much else” (Ethics in the Internet, 6).

When we search for Catholic websites, we see some are authentic, others purporting to be “Catholic.” There is “confusing proliferation of unofficial web sites labeled ‘Catholic’” (The Church and Internet, 11). How do we determine which are officially Catholic?

In this hyper-connected culture, we get addicted to the Internet. Instead of controlling our devices, we are conditioned and controlled by them. How do we solve this problem? TO BE CONTINUED.

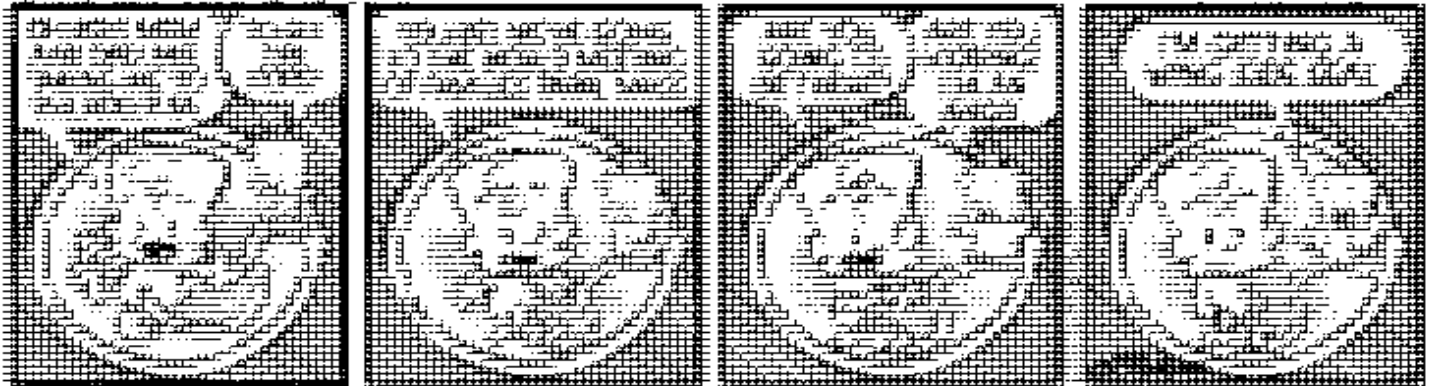
